

JANBA Tournament Attire

JANBA Tournament Rules include a dress code for suitable tournament attire.

Rule XII, Section 2: “All bowlers must be properly attired befitting a National Tournament. Shorts/skirts/skorts length must be equal to or longer than the end of your fingertips when your arm is extended down by your side. Slacks and jeans in good condition are acceptable. Inappropriate attire would include tank tops, short shorts, body suits, sweat suits, bicycle shorts, undergarment t-shirts, and headwear.

Any bowler who does not adhere to these rules will not be able to participate in the tournament.

If you are submitting an entry form, please be sure that your bowlers are aware of this dress code.

Polo shirts with collar	Crop top
Sleeveless polo shirt	Tank top
T-shirts with appropriate logo/design	Plain white T-shirt (undershirt)
Shorts/Skirts/Skorts Length must be equal to or longer than the end of your fingertips when your arm is extended down by your side.	Spandex clothing (bike shorts) Short shorts
Slacks	Warm-ups or sweatpants (no elastic cuffs)
Denim Jeans Without holes, fringes or frayed	Denim Jeans With holes, fringes or frayed
No hats to be worn	Hats, Beanies
Headgear for religious or medical reasons is acceptable.
